



CHAMPIONSHIP VILLAGE INFORMATION

EVENT WEEKEND PASSES

To book a space for your Motorhome in the Championship Village, you must have already entered to compete within the event, or purchased weekend passes through our online ticketing system. The Championship Village is for Guest Riders and British Championship Riders.

MOTORHOME/SELF SUFFICIENT VEHICLE

By entering your registration number you are confirming RHL will verify the vehicle with DVLA . If the vehicle does not meet the criteria, your booking will be cancelled and monies refunded.

ACCESS TIMES

CONDITIONS

- No movement of vehicle until ready to leave
- Vehicles will be parked up in strict order, no places can be reserved. Those arriving first will be parked nearest the event site, working back towards the pier. Only 45 places available
- All chemical toilet waste to be disposed of in Effluent tanks provided or taken home
- All waste to be deposited in skips provided
- All music to be turned off by 22.00pm
- All generators to be turned off by 23.00pm
- Anyone involved in theft, malicious damage or antisocial behaviour will be liable to immediate ejection from the site without refund of monies
- Any Competitor or persons associated with them, involved in any of the above, will be disqualified from racing
- Please be mindful of your fellow campers at all times
- No outdoor barbecues
- If bringing a bike Trailer (maximum of 1 per pitch), this must be able to fit directly behind your Motorhome and fit within the space booked, ie 10m length or 12m length space. It cannot be parked to the side of your vehicle. The Trailer must remain hooked to your vehicle at all times.

AWNINGS

The camping area is situated along the main sea front of the event site within the event boundary lines. The areas is prone to strong winds and is within close proximity to both competitors and visitors to the event. This means to comply with Event Health & Safety awnings are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**, for the safety of all concerned.

FACILITIES

- Effluent Tanks
- 24 Hour Access Security* - RHL cannot be held responsible for damage/loss of any property while on site
- Dedicated Vehicle Exit Point
- Manned security point for pedestrian access – Pass holders only - to and from the Village
- Dedicated booking in window

*(Perimeter Security Only)

PASSES

- Vehicle pass must be displayed in front windscreen at all times.
- Camping and Event Wristbands to be affixed to wrist correctly, any loose bands will be corrected accordingly
- Tampered passes will be treated as fraud and confiscated
- Only Camping Pass Holders with an Event/Rider/Mechanic pass will be allowed within Campsite area



CHAMPIONSHIP VILLAGE REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

REGISTRATION TIMES & SITE ACCESS

Thursday	20 October 2022	11.00 to 19.30
Friday/Saturday/Sunday	21 -23 rd October 2022	No Access – Registration Closed

The Championship Village is not accessible by vehicle after the 20th October 2022, due to its position within the event site. If you have any doubts about arriving within the registration time, please notify the event team and see about booking within the Premier Village, space permitting.

WELCOME OFFICE - MARINE PARADE

1. Drive up Marine Parade (BS23 1BE) – You will need your Welcome Letter and Invoice ready to show North Somerset Parking personnel, who will be situated at the beginning of Marine Parade at the entrance to the Beach Car Park. They will direct you along Marine Parade towards the main entrance to the event site.
2. Once you have proceeded up Marine Parade, a member of the Event Logistics team will direct you to park up in the holding area, on the left of Marine Parade Road, opposite the Event Welcome Office. A member of your party will be asked to proceed to the Event Welcome Office, with your Welcome Confirmation Letter, to carry out Event Registration Procedures. Riders who are present at the time the Motorhome arrives on site, must present themselves at the Camping window to carry out registration procedures at the time of collecting the Championship Camping Passes.
3. Go to the relevant Camping Window, identified as below. There will be two windows, one window will process those bookings who have riders within their party and the second window will process those bookings who are purely spectators at the event. The windows will be clearly identified, please ensure you go to the correct window, to avoid any unnecessary delays:

The windows will be identified as follows:

Camping Villages	- Riders/Spectators
RHL Village	- RHL Crew and Guests

Riders who have booked within the Championship Camping Village, will be able to carry out their Rider Registration procedures at the same time as collecting their Championship Camping Village passes, which will eliminate them having to queue on the Friday morning. For those Riders who have booked within the Village, but will not be present when the Motorhome arrives on site, please ensure the designated appointed person has a copy of the Welcome Confirmation Letter, to enable them to carry out the Championship Camping Village Registration in your absence. All passes will be allocated to this person. If the rider is a minor, the rider pass will be allocated to the legal guardian, who will be able to carry out Village and Rider Registration at the same time.

4. At the Welcome Window you will receive your People and Vehicle passes.

CHAMPIONSHIP VILLAGE REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

PASSES

1. The Camping Bands/Event Passes/Rider Passes will be allocated as set out in the Championship Camping Confirmation Letter.
2. The Vehicle Pass must be clearly displayed in the windscreen of the vehicle. – Please check this has the correct vehicle registration number displayed.

ACCESS SECURITY

1. On return to your vehicle a member of our security team will check that all passes have been securely affixed to your wrists, where applicable and your Vehicle pass is clearly visible in the window. You will be required to wear event and camping wristbands at all times, or if a rider you will be required to have your Rider Security ID on you at all times, along with your Camping Wristband affixed to your wrist.
2. Please note due to increased security measures a member of our Security Team may ask to carry out an internal vehicle inspection.
3. Once all the passes have been checked and are fitted and displayed correctly, you will then be escorted on to site and parked up in your pitch for the weekend.



PREMIER CAMPING VILLAGE SAFETY INFORMATION

FIRES

- Bonfires are NOT permitted anywhere on site, all BBQ's must be 'off the ground'
- Be aware of flying sparks/embers as they can start fires even from some distance
- Fireworks are NOT permitted on site, any found will be confiscated
- National Weather Warnings, may be that no BBQ's will be permitted. This will be updated nearer the event, if necessary

IF YOU DISCOVER A FIRE

- Evacuate the area IMMEDIATELY. This is of paramount importance
- Shout 'fire' to warn others around you
- Fire extinguishers are available for use at the ENTRANCE to the Hydrogarden Village
- In the event of a serious fire such as one involving a vehicle, dial 999 for the fire brigade
- If you are in any doubt **DO NOT** attempt to tackle fires, they can spread very quickly and produce toxic smoke fumes which can kill in seconds



MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

- If during the course of the weekend you have the misfortune to require medical assistance, please report to our on site medical facility located at the Royal Sands end of the site on the promenade. This is open during event opening hours.
- In an emergency dial **999** and notify security, located at any of the main gates or RHL Compound
- The nearest hospital Accident and Emergency Department and out of hours GP service is located at

CHAMPIONSHIP VILLAGE SECURITY

PERIMETER FENCING

- The event site is surrounded with 2.8m High Heras Fencing, in some areas it is double fenced.
- Do not break the Perimeter fencing to get out of the site, just to save a little bit of walking. Any person found to be breaking the fence will be dealt with under our Malicious Threat Policy and treated as a potential threat to the event.
- Ensure you have your wristbands on at all times. Tampered passes will be treated as fraud. Loose fitting wristbands will be adjusted accordingly.

VEHICLES & PASSES

- All Vehicles must be identified by a clearly visible authorised Camping Vehicle Pass. Any Vehicle that does not have a Vehicle Pass, will be classified as a Suspect Vehicle and will result in the vehicle being removed from site, under our Malicious Threat Policy, as a potential threat to the event.
- When entering or leaving the site by vehicle, our security team, may ask to carry out a quick search of the vehicle.
- You are reminded RHL Activities or any member of its teams are not liable for your Vehicle or Personal Possessions. It is your responsibility to take appropriate measures to protect your personal possessions especially when leaving site to socialise in the town of Weston Super Mare. All event Security are provided for the sole purpose of RHL Activities Ltd to ensure the safe running of the event.

THREATENING OR ABUSIVE ACTS

- Our Team are there for your assistance, we expect them to be treated with the same respect as you expect to be treated. Any incident in which a member of our Team is verbally abused, threatened or assaulted will be treated as a Criminal Act and will be dealt with accordingly.
- Persons involved in carrying out physical assault or damage within the event site, to any member of the RHL Team/members of public or property within the Event Site will be escorted to the RHL Compound by members of our Security Team, where they will arrange for the Local Police to come on site for the person(s) to be handed over and charged as necessary.
- If you have any concerns during the event weekend, please speak to a member of our security team, they will be easily identifiable.

MALICIOUS THREAT POLICY

Any person or persons who by carrying out an act that could jeopardise both the safety of the event and those within the event site shall be treated as carrying out a Malicious Threat and they and their property will automatically be isolated by our Security Team and will be removed from site as soon as is safely possible.

In the instance of suspect packages or vehicles, these will be automatically secured and removed from site by the appropriate professionals, without exception.
